

Groundwater and Geology: Foundation for Watershed Planning

The **Conservation Authority (CA) Geosciences Group** and **Conservation Ontario** invite practitioners working in the geoscience sector to attend a 'geoscience day' highlighting on-going research and innovative approaches to geosciences policy and watershed planning.

Groundwater and Geology: Foundation for Watershed Planning will feature presentations by experts on a range of geoscience topics. This is an exciting opportunity to learn what's new in geoscience research and data collection and how this information can be utilized in the assessment of groundwater resources and policy development.

This session is scheduled to precede the 2011 **A.D. Latornell Conservation Symposium** being held at the same venue.

Content

The morning sessions will look at CA lead/partnered geosciences projects. These will comprise a wide range of topics related to groundwater research. Highlights include the Eastern Ontario Esker Project, Isotope work on the Oakridges Moraine and the Nottawasaga Valley CA watershed, the U of Guelph fractured bedrock project, and Ontario Power generation's proposed deep geologic repository.

The first session in the afternoon will look at current Groundwater policy in Ontario (Municipal, NGO, and Source Water Protection perspectives).

The second session in the afternoon will be a roundtable discussion and will focus on issues and opportunities for groundwater policy and research in Ontario.

This workshop is intended for members from the Conservation Authorities, provincial ministries, private sector, and academia (faculty, researchers, and students) who are engaged in geosciences throughout Ontario
